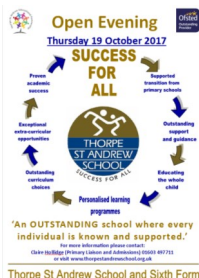


# THORPE ST ANDREW SCHOOL AND SIXTH FORM

We look forward to seeing you on the evening.

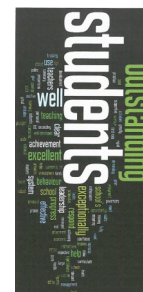

We will kick-start our Year 11 Revision programme with a motivational presentation from a guest speaker. Students will attend the presentation in their Houses, on **Tuesday 17 October 2017**. Each presentation lasts for two hours, and is full of encouragement, reassurance and aspirational ideas, as well as some practical techniques for revision planning.
