Blended learning provision

All of your lessons for **all** your subjects will receive a “live” input from your teachers starting Monday 11.1.21

What does this mean for you?

You need to be at your desk/workstation ready to learn at the start of each lesson!

You can access the live lesson on the google meet link on your google classroom for that subject. The meet link is on the home page of each classroom on the “Stream” page” click that link, that will take you to the google meet.

You must be there, logged on in the google meet at the start of the lesson when a register will be taken!

DO

- ✓ Attend on time, your camera must be on, but turn off your microphone unless the teacher asks you to speak
- ✓ Make sure that you are dressed appropriately for a lesson (That doesn't mean school uniform but you can if you want!)
- ✓ Be ready to learn with some paper and a pen in front of you
- ✓ Use the time to ask any questions if you're not sure about some work
- ✓ Use the chat function if you don't want to speak

DO NOT

- ✗ Say anything or do anything you wouldn't normally do or say in a lesson
- ✗ Be late!
- ✗ Miss this chance to see your teachers and classmates!

These live sessions won't last for the full one hour lesson. In reality they may only be the start of the lesson, but you need to be ready to learn!

Note - The only lesson where there will not be a live input at the start is for core PE. The PE department has uploaded exercise videos and ideas onto the google classroom, use these and that time to get some exercise away from a screen!
