| <p>Students will have one Textiles lesson a fortnight.</p> | <p>Students are introduced to safety in the Textiles room and some basic skills in Textiles Technology. They will learn how to use a sewing machine, traditional textiles techniques such as embroidery and more modern techniques which incorporate electronics within Textiles.</p> <p>Students will gain an understanding of how to design and make creative products, how to evaluate their own ideas and the work of others.</p> | <p>Encourage students to become creative designers.</p> <p>Equip students with skills and knowledge which can be used in other subjects and in everyday life.</p> <p>Enable students to assess and critique their own work and the work of others and use this to develop their own ideas.</p> | <p>Students complete mini workshops on tie-dye, hand embroidery and using the sewing machine.</p> <p>They will produce their own samples, a mood board, product analysis and annotated designs.</p> <p>Students will then design and make an embellished pencil case using the skills and techniques they have learnt in this unit of Design and Technology.</p> <p>Students evaluate their work once complete.</p> | <p>Students will receive a key knowledge sheet based on the project and will complete a key knowledge test towards the end of the unit of work.</p> |
