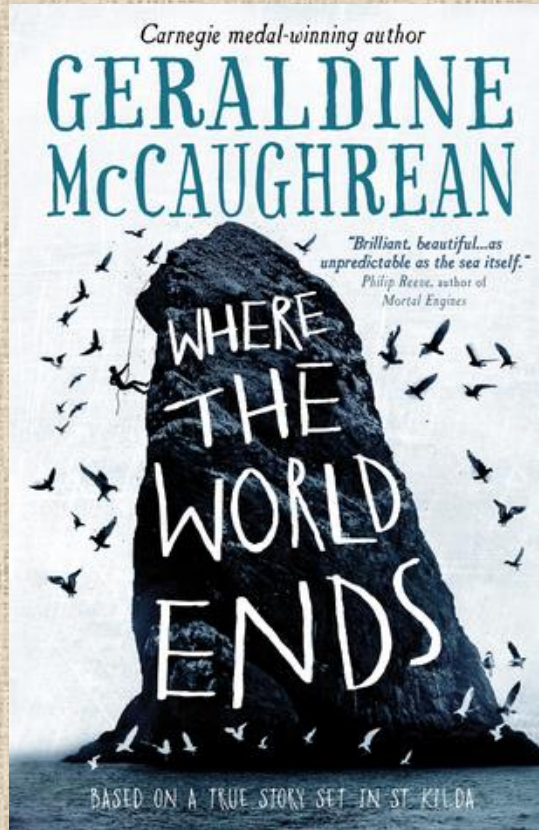


# Where the World Ends
