

# Year 12 - Careers

Students follow a programme which is in keeping with our ethos of the VOICE: Vision, Organisation, Identify, Consolidate and Effort. A substantial amount of this time is dedicated to the Vision side of this ethos, which is focused on students' next step post Sixth Form.

PD sessions in October and November are dedicated to careers, and cover a range of topics such as CV writing, Work Experience advice, and more. We also continue to use and promote tools and opportunities provided by Unifrog and Uptree, which offer a wealth of information on careers.

Also in Year 12, students and parents are offered a UCAS conference. There is also a careers day mid-March to not only look at the university option but also apprenticeships at Level 3 and Degree Apprenticeships.

This is then followed up by a Careers Fair where local and national apprenticeship and employer providers come along to talk to students face to face, as well as provide students with interview experience.
