

## Brief Summary of the Acronyms used in the Academic Reporting

Acronyms	Meaning	Explanation
<b>AP</b>	<b>Assessment Point</b>	A numerical % reflective on either a recent piece of assessment or from the combination of assessments throughout the assessment drop period.
<b>WAG</b>	<b>Working at Grade</b>	A GCSE/A level or VTQ grade based on recent assessments, taking into account current progress of NEA if applicable. It is where the student is at this point with demonstrable evidence.
<b>TPG</b>	<b>Teacher Predicted Grade</b>	A GCSE/A level or VTQ grade based on recent assessments, taking into account current progress of NEA. It is where the student may reach with demonstrable evidence so far plus potential due to attitude .
<b>PC</b>	<b>Progress comment</b>	Every data point will have an associated Progress Comment This will be reflecting teachers professional judgement on progress either above, work at or below expected progress.
