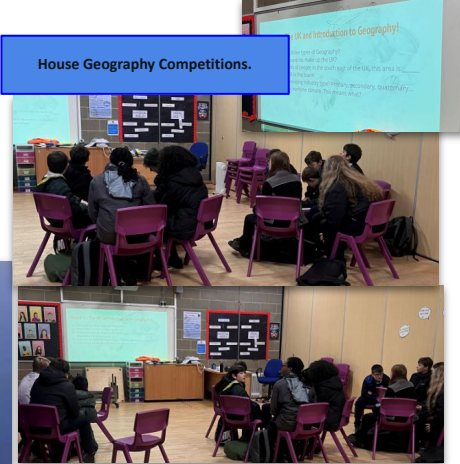
The Maths Feast Competition involves a number of different challenges which focus on students' problem-solving and teamwork skills. Well done to everyone!



TSAS raised over £1,000 from our Charity Dress Down Day and the Carol Service for our School Charity EduSpots.



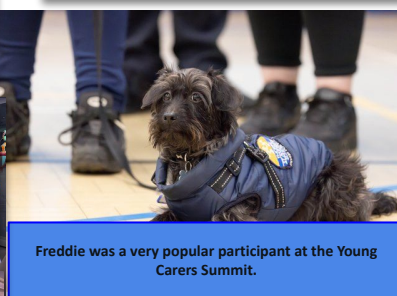

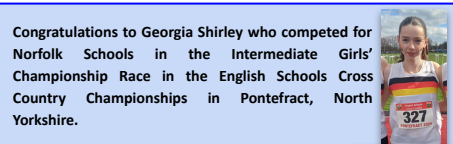

Freddie was a very popular participant at the Young Carers Summit.



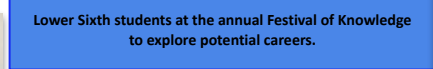

Year 8 Netball Team finished in the Top 8 at the County Finals and are Champions of the Area Tournament.



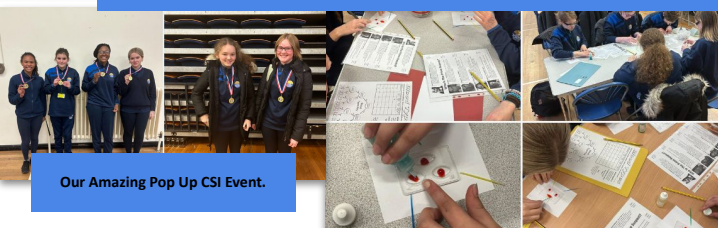

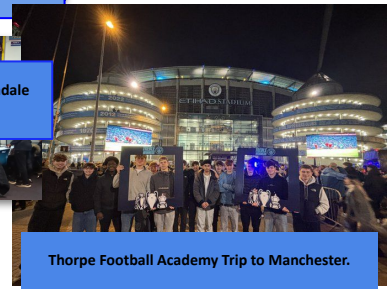

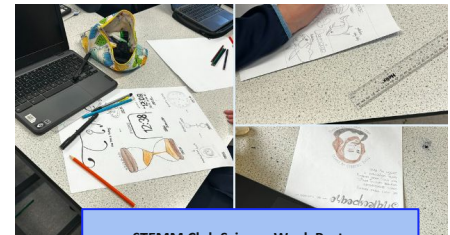

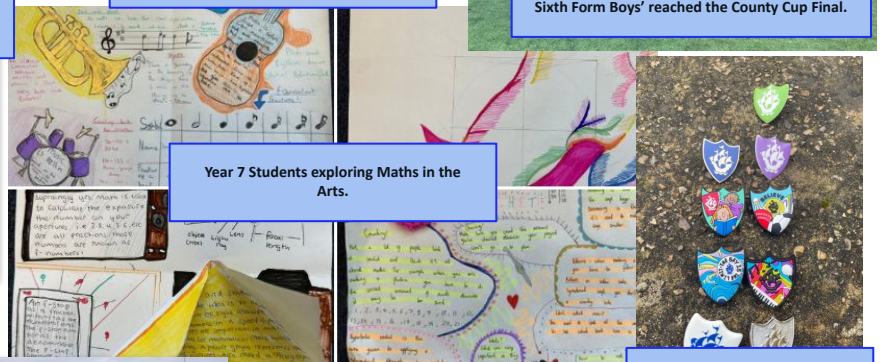

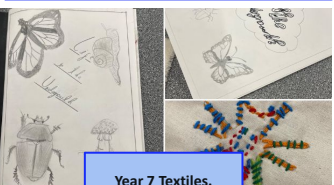

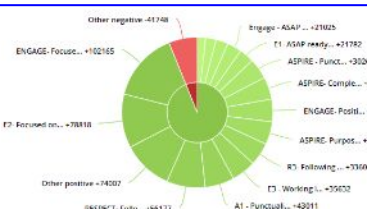
